



Biennial Sculpture Symposium + Year-Round Sculpture Walk

The initiative capitalizes on existing regional and state-wide tourism efforts to attract cultural travelers who are well-documented to spend more and stay longer in their destinations of choice. Sculpture Boothbay positively impacts both the quality of life for residents and the economic development of our region.

About the Maine Stone Symposium: Ten of Maine's most notable living stone sculptors along with a guest from Japan will transform blocks of Maine granite before our eyes from July 26 – August 4, 2019 on the Boothbay Common. The event will be free and open to the public daily. The artists will work with a wide variety of hand and powered tools to create works of art that will be sold at the Boothbay Region Land Trust's quadrennial Art Auction on Thursday, August 8, 2019 or later join the Boothbay Harbor Region Sculpture Trail.

About the Boothbay Harbor Region Sculpture Trail: The Boothbay Harbor Region Sculpture Trail is a year-round, outdoor juried exhibit. It currently consists of 18 sculptures concentrated in the downtown corridor of Boothbay Harbor. During 2019, the Trail will expand to other parts of the region. Each piece of sculpture is for sale and 100 percent of the proceeds go directly to the sculptor.
